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## Survey methodology

## Fieldwork and sampling

Eurofound's Living, Working and Covid-19 survey was launched in April 2020. As of 1 September 2020, two rounds of the survey were completed.

- Fieldwork for Round 1 started on 9 April 2020 and closed on 11 June 2020. In this report and comparisons between Round 1 and 2, only questionnaires completed before 1 May 2020 are included.
- Fieldwork for Round 2 started on 22 June 2020 for panel respondents and 25 June 2020 for public respondents and closed for everyone on 27 July 2020.
- A third round is planned for November 2020.

The survey was conducted via the SoSciSurvey platform<sup>1</sup>. It was open to respondents from all countries, but it was only promoted in the 27 European Union countries. The final report only covers EU27.

In both Round 1 and Round 2 recruitment of respondents was carried out via uncontrolled convenience sampling, specifically by publishing the link to the survey on social media and distributing it among Eurofound's contacts and stakeholders, complemented by social media advertising, targeting hard-to-reach groups.

In Round 2 an additional panel element was introduced. Round 1 collected email addresses from respondents interested in participation in further survey rounds (in accordance with GDPR). In total, 28481 emails were collected in Round 1 and 5828 emails were collected in Round 2. All Round 1 respondents who left their email received an invitation to complete Round 2 a few days before the Round 2 questionnaire was launched to the public.

As an incentive to participate in Round 2, panel respondents were asked whether they would like to receive a personalised report of the results in Round 1. Those who agreed, received a personal link, showing a visualisation of the results for all main survey questions by country, age and gender, alongside the respondent's own response given in Round 1. Emails with links to this benchmark visualisation were sent out on 7 and 8 July 2020.

Table 1 shows the final sample size in EU countries after cleaning, for the period used in the final report.

## Cleaning and weighting, effective sample size

Before data analysis, partial interviews were removed from the dataset and a few other corrections took place. Main cleaning rules included:

- Correcting for unauthorised routing (e.g. if someone indicated they were employed, filled in a
  few questions about work, then went back to change their answer to retired, their data about
  work was deleted)
- Interviews dropped before the last two pages were removed
- Interviews completed within less than 3 minutes (Round 1) or 6 minutes (Round 2) were removed
- Contradictions regarding the age of the respondent and education level as well as extreme values for age were removed.

Weighting methodology was the same in Round 1 and Round 2<sup>2</sup>. Individual level data was aggregated to have country level and EU27 averages. In order to do that, all individual responses were re-weighted to be representative of each respondent's country's demographic.




Figure 1: Unweighted sample by gender and age

In both Round 1 and Round 2, women and people aged 50-65 were overrepresented in the unweighted sample. The final unweighted sample distribution by gender and age are shown in Figure 1.

Note: the question on the respondent's gender was: How would you describe yourself? Male, Female, In another way, Don't know/Prefer not to answer. Source: FRS, Fundamental Rights Agency. The proportion of respondents selecting "In another way" was 0.3% in both rounds.

Data was weighted by age crossed with gender (in 12 age-gender combinations), urbanisation level (2 categories: urban and rural, based on respondent's own assessment collected in four urbanisation categories) and education level (2 categories: tertiary and non-tertiary).

Weighting targets for each country included:

- 2019 population estimates from Eurostat by age and gender,
- self-defined urbanisation levels by age and gender as measured in the 4th EQLS, and
- education levels by age and gender from the 2018 Labour Force Survey

Weighting was completed with the anesrake R-package (Pasek, 2020) by country, then the resulting weights were grossed up to population size. Finally, extreme weights were trimmed using the trimWeights function of the survey R-package (Lumley, 2020).

The data visualisation tool uses minimum thresholds for sample size by each population group that can be used for reporting. These minimum thresholds are based on effective sample size for each question. The effective sample size following the Kish (1965) formula not only considers the number of respondents for a given question but corrects also for the composition of the survey by taking into account the design effect due to weighting. This is particularly important for an open online survey, because the response to such surveys can be skewed towards particular demographic groups or countries. The minimum thresholds are:

- If the effective sample size is smaller than 100, results are not reported.
- If the effective sample size is 100–200, results are marked with a \* and a footnote explains that that data point has low reliability.

In analytical reports, the above rules are used for the main breakdowns by country; however, some additional analysis is included with a minimum sample size of 50 rather than a minimum effective sample size.
